E-discovery (the discovery of "electronically stored information") is no longer limited to large cases or any particular type of case. 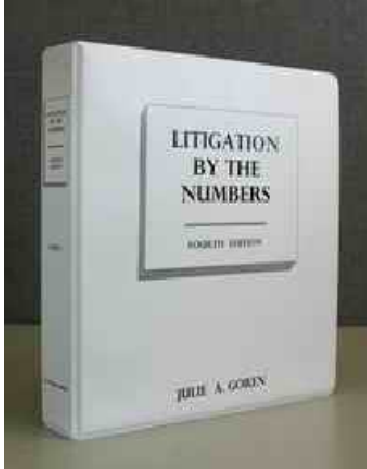
